Information on entering Germany for the Biathlon World Cup 2021 in Oberhof

(as of December 17th, 2020 - valid through January 10th, 2021)

For all persons who will be accredited by the organizing committee of the Biathlon World Cup 2021 in Oberhof, the following rules apply when entering Germany:

1. Submission of a certificate of a negative PCR test in German, English or French. The test
 - must have been carried out a maximum of 48 hours before entry, or
 - it can be carried out directly upon entry (Airport).
2. Further steps (digital registration, quarantine, etc.) only need to be taken if the person concerned is found to exhibit symptoms of Covid-19.



This holds under the “Fifth Thuringian Ordinance on Quarantine Measures for Entrants and Returnees to Combat the Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2” (<https://www.tmasgff.de/covid-19/quarantaeneverordnung>), as in § 2, para. 3, no. 5:

§ 2 - Exceptions

(3) Section 1, Paragraph 1, Clause 1 does furthermore not apply:-

5. To persons who are accredited by the respective organizing committee for the preparation, holding and follow-up of international sporting events or the participation therein or who have been invited by a federal sports association to participate in training and course measures;

Accordingly, all provisions that apply to the categories of persons under Section 1 Paragraph 1 Clause 1 therein do not apply to the exempted persons. It is not needed, as under Section 2 Paragraph 2 Clause 2 ff, to ensure sufficient safety.

As a result, an obligation to register digitally is not incurred. Whenever the persons willing to enter the country experience symptoms indicative of Covid-19, the above exemption does not apply.
